*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

The Affirmation of Faith is from the Confession of 1967 (9.20-9.21)

God the Holy Spirit fulfills the work of reconciliation in man. The Holy Spirit creates and renews the church as the community in which men are reconciled to God and to one another.
