An Invitation to Play

Throughout the Christmas season, and other places in our scriptures, God communicates with God's people in surprising ways. Through angels, dreams, burning bushes, dry riverbeds, and mysterious visitors, God continually interacts with humanity and the world. This year, as we have in years past, we will share "star words" on the second Sunday in January. Star words are an invitation to follow, like the magi followed the original star in Matthew's gospel. Since God is a creative, playful God, star words are an invitation or pathway, to play.

When you receive your star word, I hope you will welcome the opportunity to explore.

First, sit with it; pray with it. What does the word mean in relation to God? Is it an action to be done or something to be noticed? Is the word challenging or encouraging? Does it connect any thoughts or intuitions that have lingered at the back of your mind? Look up your word in a dictionary or thesaurus. Look it up in a bible search online or in your bible's concordance. Do these expanded and nuanced meanings offer any connections or eye-opening reflections? Allow the star word to be part of your weekly prayer routine. Use it as a bookmark or place it where you will see it every day. Just notice how it shows up, where it catches your attention, and how God uses the word to guide you.

As we age, our imaginative and creative selves become harder to access. We can forget how to engage the more playful and flexible parts of our minds. Our faith and our lives benefit from doing familiar things in new ways. I hope you will allow your star word to shine new light in your life.
