June is a transitional month for Christians. The fifty days between the Resurrection of Christ and the Day of Pentecost are coming to a close. Those fifty days of Easter are a time of rejoicing in the life of the church. They contain seven Sundays and the Seventh Sunday of Easter is June 1, on which we will celebrate the sacrament of communion. Pentecost Sunday arrives on June 8 and the liturgical color is red; so all of us are encouraged to wear red on Pentecost Sunday morning. "Pentecost" comes from a Greek word meaning fiftieth day. On this day, the Holy Spirit came with wind and flame, empowering the disciples to proclaim the good news of the risen Lord. Pentecost represents the culmination of the church's seven-week celebration of Christ's resurrection. June 15 is both Father's Day and Trinity Sunday. This Sunday celebrates the nature and mission of the triune God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. On June 22, we begin the season of Ordinary Time wherein the liturgical color becomes green for a very long time—almost to Thanksgiving. More on Ordinary Time next month.




